Character-building focuses on creating specific and truthful actions for the stage. In scene work, students are challenged to increase spontaneity through the use of active listening, creating believable relationships with other characters on stage, and incorporating tactics to accomplish a specific objective within a scene. Classwork culminates in an informal sharing for families on the last day of class (subject to change depending on COVID protocols).
